Fences: Tom Hidde announced that a new quote for vinyl fences was estimated to be between 37,000 to 42,000. Still need two more quotes. Mr. Hidde also discussed the possibility of cement block fence between 1st St. and the shopping center. A board member needs to discuss this possibility with the owner of the shopping center. Hopefully, he is willing to share costs.

Architectural Committee: They will begin work in January 2025. Their findings will necessitate referral to a fining committee for non-compliances. Follow-up, the establishment of a finding committee is required by Florida statute for 2025. For properties that need major improvement, it is possible to waive the fining committee findings and refer directly to the attorney for action.
